□ Have I	avoided to include publishers' names in the footnotes' references?

□ Have I	mentioned the publication place in my footnotes?
	not, please add all of them.

Publication and Year (without comma)?
If not, please adjust your footnotes [Ex.: J. Hughes, <i>Hegel and Plotinus</i> , Cambridge 1997 and <u>not</u> Cambridge University Press, Cambridge, 1997, or Cambridge, 1997]
☐ Am I certain that all the authors' first names in the footnotes are abbreviated?  If not, please check, and if needed please adjust them [Ex.: J. Locke and not John Locke]
☐ Have I used angle <i>guillemets</i> quotes (French quotation marks) [« »] to mark the quotations in the article? And also to mark Journals' names in the footnotes (see above)?
If not, please convert every other quotation mark you used.
☐ Have I used single quotation marks [''] <u>only</u> to emphasize improper expressions?
If not, please adjust them according to the editorial guidelines.
☐ Have I used single, <i>not hooked</i> quotation marks [''] instead of the curved ones ['']?
If you did it, please adjust them to the curved marks.
□ For quotations, have I used double quotation marks [ " " ] instead of guillemets? If yes, please convert them to guillemets [« »].
☐ I wrote my article in French, or using a French keyboard: are there in my article special French empty spaces between words and punctuation marks?  If yes, please remove them.
☐ Have I placed all the reference numbers of all my footnotes <i>before</i> punctuation? Example: [Spinoza's <i>Ethics</i> <sup>32</sup> ,] and not [Spinoza's <i>Ethics</i> , <sup>32</sup> ]  If not, please fix all the footnotes' numbers that are not <i>before</i> punctuation.

☐ Have I formatted every quotation of more than 3 lines as a quotation paragraph?  If not, please format them all as quotation paragraphs.
☐ Have I titled and numbered all the sections of my article?  If not, please add titles and numbers.
□ <b>Did I use automatic list to number the sections?</b> If you did so, please <u>remove</u> them and number them <u>manually</u> .
☐ Have I attached to the article a short abstract in English (150 words / 1000 characters)?  If not, please add it.
☐ Have I written my complete name in the article?  If not, please add this information.
☐ Have I added my email and academic affiliation at the end of the article?  Example: [Immanuel Kant - University of Königsberg - i.kant@unikon.pr]  If not, please add this information.
☐ Have I pointed out in the article, after my name, my ORCID Id?  If not, please add an ORCID Id. If you don't have one, please create it for that purpose
